Shen Dingli, professor of international relations and Executive Dean of the Institute of International Studies, and Director of Center for American Studies of Fudan University, Shanghai. He launched in 1991 and has since directed China's first university-based Program on Arms Control and Regional Security at Fudan. Dr. Shen specializes in regional and international security, arms control and nonproliferation, security and nuclear relations between China and the United States, and China's foreign and defense policies. He received his Ph.D. in physics in 1989 from Fudan and did post-doc in arms control at Princeton University from 1989-1991. He was an Eisenhower Fellow in 1996 and advised the then UN Secretary General Kofi Annan of his strategic planning in 2002.
