

## **Alexei Georgievich ARBATOV**

Alexei Arbatov graduated from the Moscow State Institute of International Relations in 1973. In 1982, Arbatov received a post-doctorate degree, completing his dissertation on American-Russian strategic relations. In 2003, Arbatov became a Corresponding Member of the Academy of Sciences.

Since 1976, Arbatov works at the Russian Academy of Sciences' Institute for World Economy and International Relations (IMEMO). Arbatov serves as the Head of the Institute's Center for International Security, comprising departments on nuclear nonproliferation, strategic studies, regional conflicts and terrorism. Arbatov was the Deputy Chairman of the Russian Parliament Defence Committee from 1994 till 2003.

He is a consultant to the Russian Foreign and Defence Ministries and has participated in official delegations (START-1 negotiations) and working groups (on IRF/SNF, CFE and START-2 negotiations). He is a Scholar-in-Residence of Moscow Carnegie Center. Arbatov is a member of the Governing Board of SIPRI and International advisory board of Geneva DCAF Institute and of the Center for non-proliferation of Monterey Institute.

He is the author of a number of books and numerous articles on issues of global security, strategic stability, disarmament, Russian military reform and various current domestic and foreign political issues.
